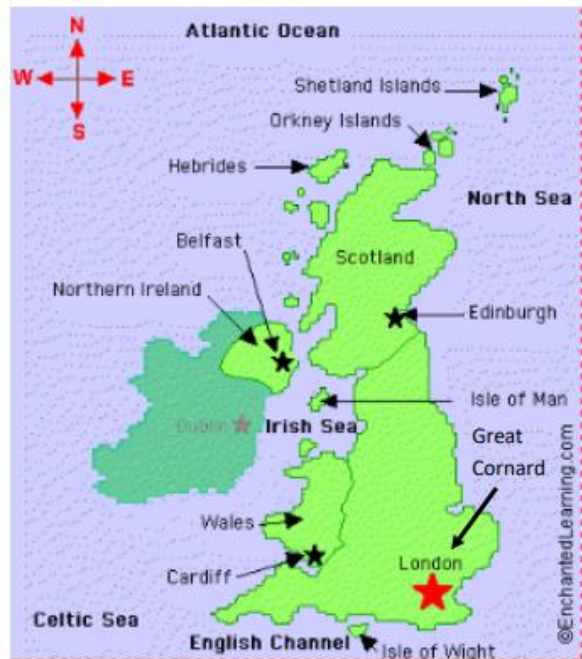


Year 1 – The United Kingdom

*Worcester is a small **city**, which is **in England**.

*There are four **countries** in the **United Kingdom (UK)**:

England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

*Each of these **countries** has a **capital city**, flag and national flower.

*The UK is officially known as the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

***Great Britain** is an **Island** surrounded by seas:

- Irish Sea, North Sea and the English Channel.

* The UK has **four seasons** and daily changes to the **weather**.

Vocabulary

Capital city – The city where the government is located. London is the capital city of the UK.

City – a large town. Worcester is a city.

Town – a built up area with houses and shops. Smaller than a city. Malvern is a town.

Village – a small group of houses. Broadheath is a village.

Country – an area of land that is controlled by its own government.

England – a country in the UK. Worcester is in England.

Island – a piece of land that is surround by water.

Great Britain – An island that is made up of England, Scotland and Wales.

Sea – a large area of salty water.
