The topic for this term is Mexico.

Many exciting opportunities will be planned to incorporate the children's ideas.

We will be continuing with the Daily Mile. Rehearsals will start for the end of year performance in the next couple of weeks until the end of term.

English

We will continue to work hard in reading and writing, even once SATs have passed. As we come towards the end of the year, we will be writing a wide variety of genres, some chosen by the children. Both classes will be given the opportunity to write instructions, news reports and character descriptions, as well as short stories.

Maths



We will still be continuing with our Singapore style maths covering a variety of areas in greater depth giving children a vast understanding of areas such as: geometry, position and movement, measurement, area and volume.

Children are still expected to be practising their times tables as these will be needed for other area of mathematics.


Topic

Our topic this term has a Geography focus. We will be learning about the Mexico, the origins of Mexico City as well as the Mayans.



Science

We will be continuing with our previous focus of evolution and inheritance before moving on to our new focus: Animals including humans. Within this we will be looking at the circulatory system and how diet and exercise affect health.



PE/Games

We will be outside for both PE and Games. We will be doing athletics on a Monday, focusing on developing strong techniques in running, throwing and jumping. We will be linking this with our maths and computing.

Each class will also participate in half a term of tennis and rounders.



Religious Education (RE)

We will be looking at an array of different religions this term comparing Sikhism, Islam and Christianity looking at their similarities and differences with consideration of what each religion deems as important.

PSHE

Transition and growing up are the main themes of our PSHE for this term, as we help the children prepare for their next step.

Art

We are investigating perspective in art, and the techniques needed to make sketches three dimensional.

Computing

We will be looking at analysing statistics from the data we have collected in our athletics sessions. We will also be using Scratch to create online games and develop our coding skills.
