Dear Families,

Over the next few weeks the children will be completing a range of assessment tasks and tests to help the teachers determine the progress that your children have made. Where ever possible, we administer these in normal, everyday class conditions so that the children are not aware or put under any pressure. As many of you are aware, a Free School application was accepted by the DFE to open North Worcester Academy as part of the Rivers Academy Trust in September 2019. A consultation was held at Northwick Manor School before Easter which showed the plans and proposed location being on the Park and Ride site. Due to increasing pupil numbers in the North Worcester area, the school places are needed but some concerns were raised regarding parking issues around the site.
