Dear Families,

Welcome back and I do hope you all enjoyed a relaxing summer holiday. The children have all settled well into their new classes and are already producing some great work. They have also been impressed with the refurbishment work that has been completed during the holiday including much needed hall re-decoration and the new Key Stage 2 pathway and fencing leading up to school.

Over the next two weeks, Year 1 to 6 class teachers will be hosting class 'Welcome to' meetings at 3.20pm that give you a range of information and an opportunity to see the classroom, meet the teacher and ask any questions you may have. The teachers look forward to meeting you and a crèche will be available in Densley Hall for Perdiswell pupils. I hope you will be able to attend. I have included more information in a separate letter emailed out today and this will also be discussed during the 'Welcome to' meetings.

But we are also very keen to hear any concerns or suggestions you may have to improve our school. 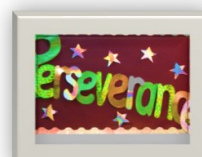
