Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to provide some final arrangements for Year 4's Young Voices trip tomorrow. Children will be required to arrive at school at the normal time. The children can come to school in their Young Voices or white t-shirt, with dark trousers or leggings. The children are to bring their Perdiswell jumper or cardigan as it will help to identify our children while we are at the arena. We would also like to thank Mr and Mrs Jeynes who have donated around 30 Santa hats.

Please ensure that children are sent to school with their normal school lunch, in addition to their packed tea. If your child is bringing two packed meals, you may want to label them with lunch and tea/dinner as children will be responsible for their own belongings. You may find it useful to send the children with disposable drinks/spoons etc that we can dispose of at the arena.

The children will set off for the Resorts World Arena at approximately 12:25pm. We would like to thank the Perdiswell PTA who have very kindly contributed the cost of the coach for the children. When we arrive at the arena, the children will be ushered to their seats where they will be based for the rest of the day. This year, we have been allocated some excellent seats where you should be able to spot us easily. We would like to remind you that once we are at the arena, we will not be able to meet you during the time of the concert.

At the end of the concert, all children will return to the coach and make their way back to the school. We aim to arrive back at the school at around 9:50pm, however, this could vary with traffic. We will update you when we are approaching school to give you an estimated time of arrival. Once we arrive at school, we will dismiss the children from the coach.

Finally, the registers will close at 10am on Wednesday morning as the children will have had a later night than usual. If you need to bring your child to school normal time, class teachers will be in class as normal.

The children are all extremely excited about the concert and they have all been practising enormously hard. The children and those of you coming to watch are certainly in for a very exciting evening.
